Landmark success for the Sherco-TVS Factory team

Our international rally credentials reached new heights with the **Sherco-TVS Factory Rally Team** securing critical victories on the European circuit. Highlighted by a decisive E3 class triumph in Spain, the team's performance validated our high-performance off-road engineering against the world's most elite competitors.

Record-breaking performance in the ARRC

The 2025 season of the **FIM Asia Road Racing Championship (ARRC)** saw TVS Racing unleash global talent aboard upgraded TVS Apache RR 310 machines. The race-spec platform established dominance on the international tarmac, setting new lap timing track records twice during the season and demonstrating superior engineering in high-pressure global environments.

Pioneering a new era in the Indian National Motorcycle Racing Championship

In a landmark development for Indian motorsport, TVSM became the first manufacturer to be entrusted with providing race-tuned machines for a national category. During the 2025 season (June 2025-January 2026), the Company served as the official machine provider for the Pro-Stock 200 class, supplying independent teams with race-tuned **TVS Apache GP200R** motorcycles to democratise the sport and elevate competition levels.

Harith Noah's relentless desert odyssey

Building on his historic class victory, TVS Factory racer Harith Noah embarked on his seventh **Dakar Rally campaign in January 2026**. Despite facing a challenging crash in Stage 1, his journey through nearly 8,000 kilometres of Saudi Arabian desert continues to showcase the resilience and world-class endurance of our riders and machines.



Four years of pioneering electric motorsport

FY 2025-26 marked the successful completion of the 4th consecutive year of **Asia's first electric one-make racing programme** featuring the **TVS Apache RTE**. This championship remains a vital testing ground for advanced electric powertrains and battery management systems, directly informing our future consumer EV roadmap.

Inaugural international season of the TVS ARE GP

Spanning June 2025 to March 2026, the first international season of the **TVS Apache Racing Experience (ARE) GP** drew over 1,100 riders across India, Mexico, Colombia, and Nepal. The grand finale at the Madras International Circuit featured 60 finalists, effectively taking our grassroots motorsport culture to a global audience.
